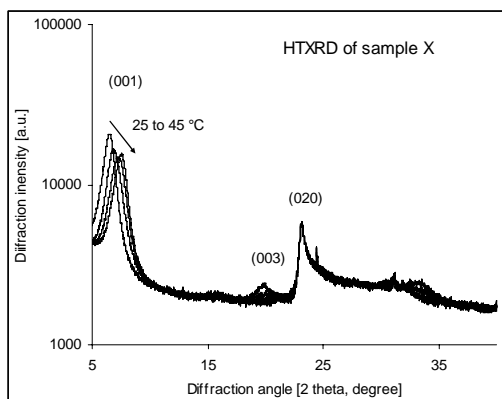


## Title of the abstract, 11 pt, Arial, bold, centred

Surname, first name, presenting author underlined<sup>1</sup>; other authors<sup>2</sup>; 10 pt, centred

<sup>1</sup> Full address and email of presenting author, <sup>2</sup> Brief names of the institutions of co-authors (not full addresses)

Abstract length maximum one page, A4 format, aligned text, line spacing 1.5, all margins 2.5 cm, Arial, 10 pt. Figures can be inserted as wmf (line drawings and graphs), 300 dpi gif (graphs), 300 dpi jpg (photographs), please, note that the final print will be in black and white.



For figure captions and better use of space around figures, please, you can arrange the corresponding part of the text in two columns. The final appearance will be adjusted by the editors of the Book of Abstracts.

Do not insert tables, texts or graphs as embedded objects (OLE) from any other computer program by copy & paste to avoid problems with the file opening using other computers.

Two letterspaces before paragraphs are enough. Up to 3 original scientific reports, either original or review papers indexed in Web of Sciences and/or Scopus or monographs can be cited [1], [2-3] using manually numbered list of references. The references to authors' own publications should be favoured.

Abstract can contain table(s). An example of the table format is shown below. The abstract file name must contain the abbreviation of the section according to the following table, surname of the presenting author, and words "oral" or "poster" according to preferred form of presentation.

Sections and abbreviations	Sections and abbreviations
Fundamentals: SS	Electrochemistry of solids: EL
Inorganic Materials: IM	Analysis and Characterization: AN
Hybrid Materials HM	Powder diffraction: DI

Example of the abstract filenames:

EL\_Goette\_oral.rtf if Goette submits one abstract and asks for a lecture

SS\_Smith\_1\_poster.doc if Smith offers more presentations and a poster for that given contribution.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Please kindly keep in mind that the abstracts will be peer reviewed by conference organizers. Novelty of the presentations and own contributions by the presenting authors will be essential for accepting the submissions, especially in the case of lectures.
